

Gumeracha Main Street Project Annual General Meeting Report – October 2017

The Gumeracha Main Street Project is a community-led initiative aimed at achieving economic sustainability of local businesses, improved visual appearance and changed traffic behaviour. Following community and business meetings in September and October 2016, a voluntary Working Party was formed in December 2016. Comprising residents and business owners, the Working Party is collaborating with the community and all levels of government to achieve a range of objectives over the coming ten years.

The Main Street Working Party acknowledges that the township of Gumeracha is built on the land of the Peramangk Peoples - the Traditional Owners of the region known today as the Adelaide Hills. We pay our respects to Peramangk Elders past and present.

The Vision for Gumeracha's Main Street, developed through consultation, is built around the themes of Peramangk Culture and Harmony, Friendly, Nature, Abundance, Linger, Discovery, Uninhibited and Safe.

For the purpose of the Main Street Project, the Main Street of Gumeracha is described as from the school/hospital at the western end to the Rocking Horse at the eastern end - 1.4 kilometres. Our ultimate goal is to underground the powerlines along the Main Street.
